Bishkek off-grid solar

Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers Akylbek Japarov; Minister of Energy Taalaibek Ibrayev; Deputy Minister of Education and Abazbek uulu Rasul; Rector of KSTU, Mirlan Chynybaev; U.S. Ambassador to the Kyrgyz Republic Lesslie Viguerie; and USAID Mission Director Kaya Adams participated in the official inauguration ceremony. For step-by-step instructions on how to apply for a tourist visa, please refer to our Embassy's website: <https://kg.embassy.gov/visas-tourism-visitor/>. Once you have completed the DS-160 form and paid the visa fee, you will need to schedule an interview appointment online.

After submitting required visa documents or attending an interview, you can track the status of your visa application using this link: <https://ceac.state.gov/CEAC>.

In order to renew your passport, you will need to make an appointment online. You can renew your U.S. passport or apply for a U.S. passport for your child by checking our website: <https://kg.embassy.gov/passports/>. This page now includes a passport wizard to help you identify the correct forms and documents that you will need to bring to the Embassy. In general, applicants should bring a completed application form, the passport they are replacing, and originals and photocopies of any required documents (including a photocopy of the biodata page of the current passport).

U.S. citizen parents may be able to transmit their citizenship to their children, even if the child was born overseas. You may apply for a Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA) and passport at the same time by completing both applications together. In the case of an arrest of a U.S. citizen, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic is expected to

notify the Embassy within 3 working days from the date of an arrest. The Embassy posts the list of English-speaking lawyers on its website. You can contact them directly for assistance. The Consular Section is authorized to conduct prison visits to ensure that prison officials are providing appropriate medical care and can provide a general overview of the local criminal justice process.

Yes, your 16 year old child can come to the interview alone. S/he will need to show that at least one legal parent or legal guardian is aware that they are applying for a passport

All passport, CRBA, and notarial services are available by appointment. Interview slots are usually available twice a month, on Mondays and sometimes Tuesdays. Appointments may be scheduled using our online system: [tinyurl /ACSBishkek](https://tinyurl.com/ACSBishkek)

You will need to check our online appointment system regularly to look for an earlier available slots. If you decide to change your previously scheduled appointment, please be sure to have your Confirmation ID.

The letter given to you by the consular officer at the interview has instructions on how to complete your application. Please follow the instructions in the letter.
