



Cost savings athens

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A one week trip to Athens usually costs around \$1,130 (\$1,078) for one person and \$2,259 (\$2,156) for two people. This includes accommodation, food, local transportation, and sightseeing.

A two week trip to Athens on average costs around \$2,259 (\$2,156) for one person and \$4,519 (\$4,312) for two people. This cost includes accommodation, food, local transportation, and sightseeing.

A one month trip to Athens on average costs around \$4,842 (\$4,620) for one person and \$9,683 (\$9,240) for two people. The more places you visit, the higher the daily price will become due to increased transportation costs.

Athens is a vibrant city teeming with activities and adventures. Whether you're a frugal traveler or someone ready to splurge, you'll find your niche in this dynamic place. Visitors can find a range of options for accommodation from high-end luxury hotels to mid-range places to budget-friendly hostels.

On average, budget travelers spend \$68 (\$63) per day, mid-range travelers spend \$168 (\$154) per day, and luxury travelers spend around \$402 (\$368) per day. These costs are calculated from the expenses of previous travelers to Athens.
