

Electricity market brazzaville

Congo is located in Sub-Saharan Africa, and is bordered by Gabon, Cameroon, the Central African Republic, and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). Its capital city is called Brazzaville. Its main resources are hydrocarbons, wood, and minerals.

Marketed gas production increased from 0.1 bcm in 2010 to 0.53 bcm in 2015 and 1.1 bcm in 2022. Most of the production is associated with oil production. Three fourth of the gross gas production is flared or reinjected (17% flared and 59% reinjected in 2022 according to Cedigaz).

In 2022, total energy consumption per inhabitant was around 0.6toe (0.2toe without biomass), in line with the Sub-Saharan Africa average, including 270kWh of electricity (around 20% below the regional average).
