

Electricity safety new delhi

In light of the monsoon season and the risks of water-logging, Delhi BSES has issued a comprehensive advisory to ensure public safety and prevent electricity-related mishaps.

Main Switch Protocol: Turn off the main switch if there is water logging or leakage observed in the meter cabin. Only turn it back on after ensuring all faults have been properly rectified.

Use a Tester: Keep a "Tester" at home. If a switch is wet, do not touch it. First use a "Tester" to check for electricity leakage. If necessary, call your electrician.

On Friday, Delhi experienced the arrival of the monsoon, resulting in a record-breaking 228.1 mm of rainfall, the highest since 1936. The intense downpour caused widespread flooding in various parts of the city and led to several fatalities.

In anticipation of heavy rain forecasted until July 2, civic bodies in Delhi have increased manpower and equipment deployment to manage waterlogging and maintain high alertness among field units.
