Meanwhile, on November 18, Azerbaijan''s Energy Minister, Parviz Shahbazov, formalised a partnership in renewable energy with the Chinese electrical engineering firm TBEA Co., Ltd.

The agreement encompasses collaboration in several key areas, including the supply of ultra-high voltage direct current (DC) and alternating current (AC) products, the manufacture of advanced energy equipment, the development of a data centre, and involvement in regional green energy connectivity initiatives.

TBEA Co., Ltd., previously known as Tebian Electric Apparatus, is a leading Chinese manufacturer of power transformers and electrical equipment. It is also a key player in power transmission projects. Alongside its competitors Tianwei Baobian Electric (TWBB) and XD Group, TBEA is recognised as one of China's largest producers of transformers.

BAKU, Azerbaijan, November 20. Azerbaijan"sMinistry of Energy signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) onenergy storage with China Southern Power Grid International (HongKong) Co., Ltd. and Powerchina Huadong Engineering CorporationLimited at COP29 in Azerbaijan"s Baku, Trend reports via the ministry"s statement.

The MoU delineates collaboration in domains including pumpedhydro storage systems (PHS), battery energy storage systems (BESS), high-voltage direct current (HVDC) transmission systems, and further technologies for alternative energy transmission, distribution, and grid modernization. A steering committee and aworking group will be formed to improve coordination and supervise the processes for effective implementation.

Before the signing ceremony, the Energy Minister ParvizShahbazov met with delegations from the companies, led by VicePresidents Fan Yalang, Liu Shaoquan, and Zhu Bo.

The meeting discussed the strategic partnership betweenAzerbaijan and China as well as prospects for cooperation inrenewable energy and energy storage technologies under thememorandum.

To note, the 29th session of the Conference of the Parties to the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP29), which willrun until November 22, opened at the Baku Olympic Stadium onNovember 11. It is the largest event organized by Azerbaijan todate, and the first time in the region that it is being held inAzerbaijan.

The main expectation from COP29 is to agree on a fair and ambitious New Collective Quantitative Goal (NCQG) on climatefinance. The COP29 chairmanship has launched 14 initiatives that include linkages between climate action and the SustainableDevelopment Goals, including green energy corridors, green energy storage, harmony for climate resilience, clean hydrogen, methanereduction in organic waste, action on

green digital technologies, and other topics.

In addition to being a top priority that creates the conditions for action, creating climate finance will also help fulfill the 1.5? C pledge by bringing everyone together.

The UN Framework Convention on Climate Change is an agreementsigned at the Rio Earth Summit in June 1992 to prevent dangeroushuman interference in the climate system. The acronym COP(Conference of Parties) stands for "Conference of Parties" and is highest legislative body overseeing the implementation of the Framework Convention on Climate Change.

A total of 198 countries are parties to the Convention. Unlessotherwise decided by the parties, COP is held annually. The firstCOP event was held in March 1995 in Berlin, and its secretariat islocated in Bonn.
