Review your energy plan's EFL for potential hidden payments, such as taxes, government fees, and early termination fees (ETF). Fees vary by provider, plan, and location, but your EFL will display what is included in your electricity rate and what is additional. For example, the ETF for TXU Energy's Free Pass 24 plan is \$295, while TXU's Free Nights and Solar Days 12 plan's ETF is \$150. If you move out of a provider's service area, you will not pay an ETF.

While free nights and weekend electricity in Texas is attractive, a fixed-rate plan may be easier to understand, require less energy tracking, and save more money, depending on your energy habits. Typically, plans offering free energy cost more per kilowatt-hour (kWh) than a fixed-rate plan. For example, the lowest available rate
