Malabo australia solar power

The Albanese Government has approved the Muskerri Solar Power Station, a 250-megawatt (MW) solar farm with 200MW battery storage, to be built 30km northeast of Bendigo.

Featuring approximately 500,000 solar panels connected to existing transmission infrastructure, the project is expected to cut greenhouse gas emissions by 495,000 tonnes annually, equivalent to removing 155,000 cars from the road for a year.

According to Tanya Plibersek, Minister for the Environment and Water, careful site selection and design have ensured minimal environmental impact, aligning with government standards for sustainable development.

"Australians have a choice between a renewable energy transition that's already underway and driving down prices, or paying for an expensive nuclear fantasy that would deliver around 4 per cent of our energy needs and add 1.7 billion tonnes to Australia's carbon emissions."
