

Porto novo electric vehicle charging

To learn about the charging costs at any location on the map, simply click on the pin icon. You'll see a cost field that displays pricing information contributed by fellow charger users. Occasionally, you can also find pricing details included in the charger's description. However, please keep in mind that pricing information may not be available for certain locations.

Click on a specific charging station pin on the map and look for information about the types of connectors available. If it's Tesla-compatible, it should list Tesla-specific connectors. You may also find information in the reviews and comments on the location.

Each charging station is rated based on user experiences, ranging from 1 to 10, with 10 indicating the highest satisfaction. Negative user reports lower a station's score, while positive reports increase it. Neutral comments and check-ins do not influence the overall score. It's also beneficial to peruse location comments for a better understanding of the rationale behind each rating. You can find PlugScores through the Station Summary icon on the map.

Porto has provided 12 electric charging stations (PCE) for automobiles in eight different locations within the municipality. EDP Comercial (TDA member), HorizonDistance, Kilometer Low Cost and Mobiletric are the operators in charge of managing the car Electric charging stations, distributed throughout the city.

This initiative started by launching a tender to implement electric charging stations at the end of 2019 and is part of the municipal strategy to promote an increasingly less polluting city.

In recent years, the Municipality of Porto has invested in the electric mobility sector, both in terms of the acquisition of electric vehicles for its fleet, and in terms of promoting initiatives in this area, namely through positive discrimination in parking policies in the Municipal Parks.
